<p>Students are assessed using a number of skills encompassed under four main headings.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Analyse• Comprehend• Discover• Resolve. <p>Each skill has a level known as a step and year 9 students are assessed using mainly step one skills, two and three skills with some step four skills.</p>
