How will my son be assessed?

Assessments will address a variety of skills

- Change and continuity
- Source analysis
- Cause and consequence
- Historical enquiry
- Knowledge and understanding
- Interpretations analysis

Assessments will be through a variety of formats

- Extended pieces of writing
- Pamphlets
- Diary entries
- Group work
- Class presentations

Each assessment measures a set of skills which are marked as following, using our Doodle system:

- Red – Skill not yet shown
- Amber – Skill developing
- Green – Skill secure

How can I support my son with History?

- Reading over notes made in lesson
- Encourage him to read over his work after each day to secure his learning and where appropriate make improvements
- He should respond to all teacher marking in his book (preferably in a different coloured pen)
- Check his planner to make sure he is up to date with his homework
