Y10

- Using resources

How will my son be assessed?

Exams are all sat in the Summer term of Y11.

- 2 exams
- Each is 1 hour 45mins long
- Each is worth 100marks (50%of overall grade)
- Questions can be multiple-choice, structured, closed, short answer and open response.

- Foundation and Higher Tier papers.
- 1-9 Grading scale

Assessment objectives

- AO1: Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of: scientific ideas; scientific techniques and procedures - 40%
- AO2: Apply knowledge and understanding of: scientific ideas; scientific enquiry, techniques and procedures – 40%
- AO3: Analyse information and ideas to: interpret and evaluate; make judgments and draw conclusions; develop and improve experimental procedures – 20%

#NB – There is no controlled assessment – practical skills will be developed within the lessons and examined in the paper exams

How can I support my son with the Chemistry course.
