How will my son be assessed?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unit 1 - Written examination set and marked by Pearson. • 90 marks. • Two hours. • Unit 11 - A task set and marked by Pearson and completed under supervised conditions. • The supervised assessment period is nine hours arranged over a number of sessions in a three-week assessment period timetabled by Pearson. • Completed using a computer and submitted electronically. • 80 marks. • Unit 14 - A task set and marked by Pearson and completed under supervised conditions. • The supervised assessment period is eight hours arranged over a number of sessions in a three-week assessment period timetabled by Pearson. • Completed using a computer and submitted electronically. • 68 marks. • Unit 10, 19 and 12 - internally assessed based on coursework assignments, subject to external standards verification.
