We are looking for a committed and enthusiastic teacher of science to join our very strong department. The department consists of 11 teaching staff and 2 technicians in newly refurbished science labs. As a STEM Assured School, Science is hugely popular at KS5 across all three disciplines with nearly 200 taking these at AS/A2 level. Many pupils go onto read science subjects at university level. The appointed candidate will teach KS3 - KS5 and across all ability ranges in a very supportive environment.

Ernest Bevin College is an 11-19 boys' school with 1250 on roll. We have a mixed sixth form of 370 students based in state of the art buildings with good transport links. Our last Ofsted inspection judged the school to be OUTSTANDING.

In 2017, 63% of pupils obtained both English and Maths at GCSE at Grade 4+, 33% obtained the EBacc at Grade 4+. Last year 130 students from our 6th Form went to University, 70 to study STEM related subjects.

We are an Elite Sports College competing at national and international level in a range of sports. We have full time coaches for volleyball, judo and table tennis and fantastic sports facilities including a swimming pool and fitness studio. These facilities are extensively used by students and staff free of charge.

We are one of only 4 schools in the country to have been awarded STEM Assured status, the only school in London to have a Combined Cadet Force on site and we have recently formed a Cricket Academy in partnership with Twenty20 Community Cricket. We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and staff. The position is subject to an enhanced DBS check. Visits to the college are welcome.
