We are seeking to recruit a person to manage and run our Staff Room Food Service. Duties would include sourcing snacks, sandwiches and drinks and selling these products to members of staff at break and lunch time in our friendly and busy staff room. This opportunity has arisen following the retirement of a long standing member of staff and is being offered on small business/self-employed basis with the successful applicant keeping the profits made.

Ernest Bevin College is a community school for boys aged 11-19 and with a mixed Sixth Form with over 1250 children on site. Over 150 staff are employed by the college and there is limited opportunity for staff to leave the site at lunchtime due to pupil supervision duties. Some staff eat a cooked meal in the dining room with the children but a large number prefer to relax in the staff room and buy a sandwich or snack. There is plenty of scope to develop this service which is well supported by our staff.

Ernest Bevin College is an 11-19 boys school with a mixed sixth form of 350 students based in state of the art buildings especially in STEM subjects, and with good transport links. Our last Ofsted inspection in October 2011 judged the school to be OUTSTANDING.

In 2016, 60% of pupils obtained both English and Maths at GCSE, 34% obtained the Ebacc and over a 100 pupils out of a cohort of 150 have gone to University, over 60 in STEM related subjects. We are one of only 4 schools in the country to have been awarded STEM status, one of 2 schools in London to have a Royal Marines CCF Section, we also opened our Cricket Academy this September.

We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and staff. The position is subject to a DBS check.
