The successful candidate will support identified pupils to access the academic and social curriculum in order to achieve their expected levels of progress. You will need to be flexible and able to work under pressure and have an understanding of equal opportunities. We have a high success rate of Learning Support Assistants embarking on QTS programmes.

Ernest Bevin College is an 11-19 boys school with a mixed sixth form of 350 students based in state of the art buildings especially in STEM subjects, and with good transport links. Our last Ofsted inspection in October 2011 judged the school to be **OUTSTANDING**.

In 2016, 60% of pupils obtained both English and Maths at GCSE, 34% obtained the Ebacc and over a 100 pupils out of a cohort of 150 have gone to University, over 60 in STEM related subjects. We are one of only 4 schools in the country to have been awarded STEM status, the only school in London to have a Combined Cadet Force on site and have opened our Cricket Academy this September.

We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and staff. The position is subject to a DBS check.
