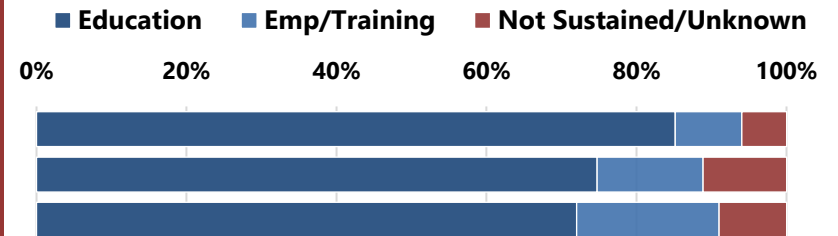


# J. Destinations After KS5

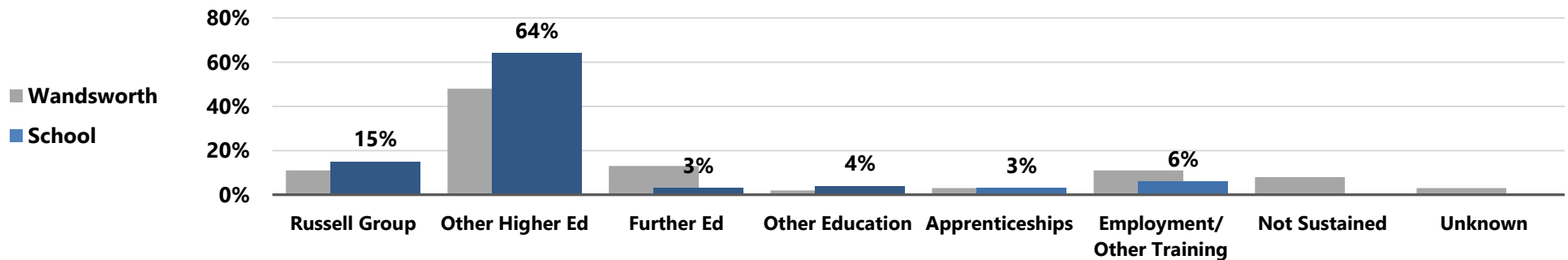
## i) Destinations Summary for 2015 KS5 Finishers

Unknown includes students who were not matched by the DfE in the datasets used to track destinations.
