Sixth Form Enrolment 2017- external candidates

The 2017/18 enrolment process for Ernest Bevin College's Sixth Form is on **Friday 25th August**, the day after GCSE results day. Ernest Bevin is a community school in Tooting Bec with good transport links and admits both boys and girls to the Sixth Form. We can not guarantee to offer all applicants a place but we have a wide range of A Levels and BTEC Level 2 & 3 courses and, subject to interview, we will do our best to offer as many students as possible places on an appropriate course.

All external candidates wishing to start **Year 12** must arrive at Ernest Bevin College promptly at **9.30am on Friday 25th August** and make themselves known to members of Sixth Form staff who will be in the main Reception/atrium area. We will endeavour to interview students (who have not previously applied to Ernest Bevin) on the day. You are welcome to bring a parent with you to support you in the interview and there will be an opportunity to ask questions.

Please **have with you:**

- ❖ **a copy** of your 2017 GCSE/BTEC results slips / certificates
- ❖ If you were entitled to extra time in your GCSE examinations you must also bring a copy of your current Form 8
- ❖ In addition, if you are offered a place at Ernest Bevin College, students will be expected to pay an **enrolment fee of £50** (Please note we do not take payment by card) to help cover the increasing costs of photocopying, ID passes and other expenses incurred during the year. We endeavour to keep this fee as low as possible and believe, it is in line with, or lower than comparative schools

In most cases we should be able to let you know on the day if we will be able to offer you a place, although it may be subject to a reference from your previous school. Students should expect to stay the morning in college so that you can complete the enrolment process if you are offered a place. This will help Sixth Form lessons to begin as early as possible.

The academic year will start on **Wednesday 6th September** with tutor time, when time tables will be issued and tutors will go through college rules and expectations. Lessons will start on Thursday 7th September and all students are expected to arrive in college by 8.50am ready and equipped to begin lessons.
